Stones River Manor, Murfreesboro's first home for the aged and Rutherford County's only nonprofit, faith-based senior living community, held the groundbreaking celebration for their new, 30-bed skilled nursing and rehabilitation facility. Also included in the expansion plan is a new 24-bed Alzheimer's and dementia care facility, known as their Assured Care Center, which will replace their existing 22-bed facility.

The added skilled nursing level will complete the full spectrum of care provided on Stones River's campus. Independent living apartments and five levels of assisted living care are currently provided in addition to adult day care and respite services, plus a broad range of clinical and therapy services.

J&S Construction Company of Cookeville, Tennessee, specialists in LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) construction, will be the general contractor and will be working with local vendors and subcontractors. J&S was also the contractor for the Manor's last major expansion project which was the first LEED certified project in senior care in the state of Tennessee. That project was awarded with the Gold Level LEED Certification by the Green Energy Council. The project Architect is Jim Vaughn of Berry & Prindle Architects in Louisville, Kentucky.

Additional facilities and services that will be coming with this new expansion include a ten-bed special needs care center, expanded adult day care services, and a new chapel and chaplain's office.

Kirkland A. Mason, CEO for Stones River Manor, said that the new facilities are the result of years of planning and preparation, and will cap off a ten-year expansion plan that started in 2007. Future expansions will include more independent living apartments and expanded geriatric services, as well.

The new center is scheduled to open in September of 2017.
