During the design phase, Advanex officials strategized with J&S Construction to place an emphasis on customizing its facility to support creativity, focus and teamwork. J&S Construction’s in-house design team created an open concept office layout that will have generous space for informal meetings including sleek administrative areas, large conference rooms, and plenty of second floor capacity that will give way for continued growth within the company.

The building’s main entrance will boast large storefront doors and windows that will lead guests and employees into a chic office area. The interior finishes will lend a clean, professional look, and the inviting space will also include an outdoor covered patio with ample seating for employees to enjoy during breaks. The approximately 40,000 square-foot production space will house two loading docks, a full-height positive pressure room with high speed doors, and generous space for raw storage and manufacturing. SAIC's First Technology Corridor Completed with 'Dream Team'



Cummins Filtration, a world leader in OEM and aftermarket filtration solutions for diesel engines, transmissions and industrial applications, has been designing and manufacturing cutting-edge filter media technology for diesel engines since 1958.

The global power leader will soon be using its Cookeville site to produce diesel engine filtration used in ASTM level 2 face masks. Cummins recently partnered with J&S Construction to install a 24-foot tall aluminum silo with the capacity of 67,000 pounds which will be used to store polypropylene pellets. Cummins is using its own proprietary charged enhanced meltdown polypropylene that features a high bacterial filter efficiency yet retain high breathability. This technology was developed in cooperation with the University of Minnesota.

Five Tips for Keeping Promises

Most of us make promises for good reasons. Maybe we want to support our co-workers' projects, or help a team member to achieve that well-deserved pay raise. Or perhaps, we want to be reliable and get home on time. But, we sometimes need strategies that will help us to stick to what we say. Listed below are some pointers you can follow:

1. Be Organized - We often make promises impulsively. But, it's wiser to stop and think before you agree to act. Check your calendar for scheduling clashes. Be sure that you have the resources to complete the task. And clarify exactly what you're committing to. Don't say "yes" if you've any doubt that you'll be able to keep a promise. Instead, politely decline the request, or negotiate a compromise.

2. Be Motivated - It's much easier to keep a promise when you genuinely want to do so. You're enthusiastic and you'll not let anything get in your way. But think carefully about your motives for agreeing to a request. Do you really want to help out, or are you saying "yes" just because it would please people?

3. Be Honest - There will always be occasions when you know that you can't deliver, so just be honest about it. It can be painful to turn down requests for help, or to admit that you don't have the capacity or the ability to do something. But, it's far better to do so than to risk giving people false hope, or to be untruthful.

4. Be Principled - People sometimes excuse their promise-breaking by claiming something like, "Well, that's business!" Avoid falling back on "get-out clauses" like these. They put your honesty, dependability and reputation on the line. Instead, be guided by your values and principles, and strive for high standards of behavior.

5. Be Apologetic - Sometimes, events outside our control block all of our efforts to honor our word, however hard we try. Illness, family emergencies, and equipment malfunctions are forgivable. Even so, it's important to recognize that we have let someone down, and to apologize. People will appreciate it, and they'll give you the benefit of the doubt next time.
